## *Obituary*

Timothy Godlock, Jr. (better known as T.J./BooBoo) entered this earthly realm on December 10, 1981 to the loving parents Timothy Godlock, Sr. and Rita Jean Bibbs-Godlock in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and his precious soul was called to heaven's realm on January 17, 2014 with his family and friends at his bedside. At infancy, he was diagnosed with Sickle Cell Anemia; growing older was determined to not be defined by it.

T.J. attended Bodine Elementary, primary years where he entered into the National Invention Convention for two self-prepared inventions. Both inventions placing in the top three earned him awards, plaques and two separate occasions where he met Oklahoma's ten Governor Walter. T.J. played baseball and football, activities which provided normalcy from his health; T.J. ran up and down field pitches fearlessly.

T.J. transitioned into secondary education attending Roosevelt Middle School and in May 2000, received his diploma from Frederick Douglass High School. Thriving into a nice young man, he unfortunately led astray in 2007 and was incarcerated by the State of Oklahoma, time he took for enlightenment. He bided his time by receiving culinary skills, becoming a fine chef and paroled home in November 2010 by which he found self-purpose through God. He was christened as an infant. A member of St. Mary's C.M.E., he gave his life to Christ, morphing into a respected man. He'd been an active member since the age of 4, this past year attending church services faithfully; his Christian duties leading him to aid the Meals On Wheels program; a family inspired activity.

T.J. was preceded in death by both grandfathers, Louis D. Bibbs (Oklahoma City, OK) and Obie Godlock, Sr. (Gladewater, TX). He is survived by parents Timothy Godlock, Sr. and Rita Bibbs-Godlock; grandmothers, Lillian H. Bibbs (Oklahoma City, OK) and Texana Godlock (Gladewater, TX); three siblings, Reginald J.
