Obituary

Hosley Littlejohn was born on June 11, 1923 to Dock and Doney Hill Littlejohn in Gay, Oklahoma.

He grew up in the Gay community, where he went to grade school, then attended and graduated from Booker T. Washington School in Hugo, Oklahoma.

On December 30, 1942 he was inducted into the U. S. Army, and during his tenure in the military, his main specialty was driving trucks across the Burma Road in Central Burma, India. He received the Good Conduct Medal. On February 6, 1946 he was Honorably Discharged from military service, having attained the rank of Corporal.

On November 6, 1950 he married Erma Walker and to this union 13 children were born. They moved to Oklahoma City in 1951, where Hosley worked at Tinker Air Force Base and Acme Grocery Store. He was a member of Greater New Zion Baptist Church for a number of years.

Hosley was preceded in death by his parents, Dock and Doney Littlejohn; 11 brothers and sisters: Ada Jones, Stella Nash, Arthur Littlejohn, Zebedee Littlejohn, Rev.
