

I'm Free

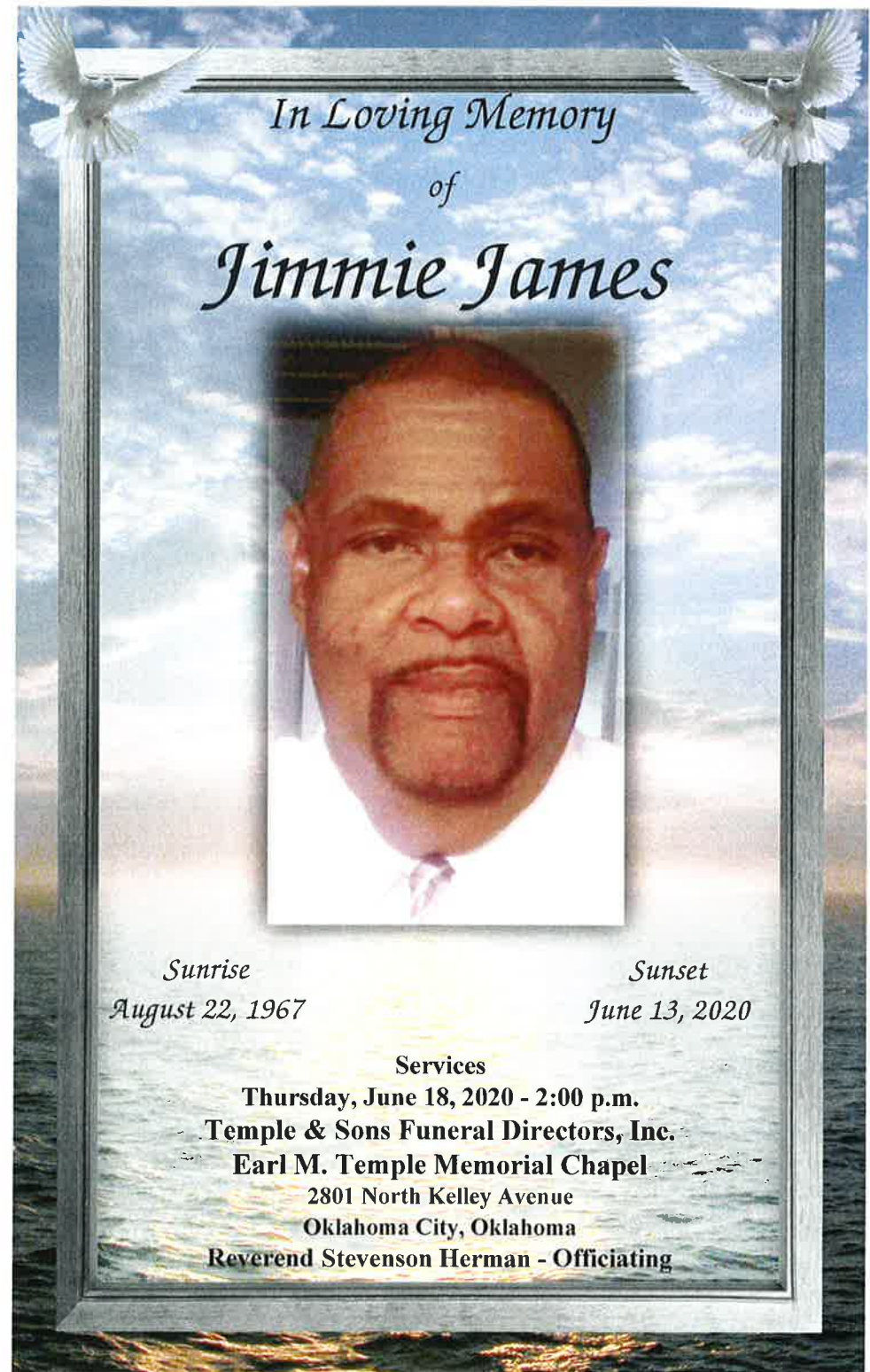
*Don't grieve for me, for now I'm free
