On Tuesday, August 25, 2020, Mr. Robert L. Rusher, departed this life to be with his Heavenly Father at age 96. He was born February 3, 1924, in Washington, Georgia to Annie Mae and George Rusher. He was the 5th child of seven brothers and one sister. His parents, wife, Maxine Rusher and two sons, Walter L. Roberson and Robert E. Rusher preceded him in death.

Mr. Rusher was a World War II Veteran, inducted into the United States Army December 1, 1945, he fought in both the Korean War and WWII. where he received the Victory Medal and the Bronze Star. He served as Corporal until November 30, 1948, when he received an Honorable Discharge.

While stationed at Ft. Sill, Lawton, Oklahoma he met the love of his life, and was married December 2, 1948, to Maxine Marie Roberson and to this union there were six children Walter Roberson, Anna, Jackie, Bernard, Doris, and Robert Ellis.

In 1956, he and his family moved from Chickasha to Oklahoma City, due to his employment at Tinker AFB. They were active members of the Church of the Living God in Chickasha. Then they became active members of the church in Oklahoma City, located at 625 N. Kelham. He was a faithful member of the Usher Board for 50 years and served as President for a term. Within the church he held many hats; Father of the Church, Deacon, Usher (Emeritus) and was a City Wide Usher. Deacon Rusher had a great love for his Pastor and Church Family.

Mr. Rusher retired from Tinker Air Force Base with 34 years of federal service. He was later employed as a transportation specialist for Oklahoma City Community Action.

Daddy's passion was playing dominoes. Monday thru Friday he went to the nutritional center for lunch and to fellowship with friends and play dominoes. Whenever the doors to the Center were open, Daddy was there. Daddy was a man we all loved and respected in the community. A man of integrity. He would go out of his way to help others in any way that was needed. When it came to his children, there was no good thing he would withhold from us.
