# Obituary

Cleo Phillips was born to the late, Sim and Julia Phillips of Teague, Freestone County, Texas. Cleo grew up on his parents farm; they led a life before him that caused Cleo to grow up helping others and trying to do what he thought was right. He learned well, to "treat people like you want to be treated". He became a New Testament Christian, commonly called the Church of Christ, (Matt. 16:18), during his early teenage years; and was active in the Church from that point on, leading congregational singing, teaching the bible and preaching the gospel of Christ. He also served as a deacon and an elder, for many years in the Lord's Church. His greatest passion, throughout his converted life, was to share the word with anyone interested in knowing God's truth, rightly divided, (II Tim. 2:15). Because heaven and hell are real, he wants everyone to know the truth, (Jn. 8:32) (Rev. 20:14,15).

Cleo graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in 1960, in Teague, Texas. He later married Mary Louise Henderson, also of Teague.

He attended and graduated from Preston Road School of Preaching in Dallas, Texas and preached the gospel in Texas, California and Oklahoma. He also attended Central State University and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree; and later a Master of Education degree. For a time, his career was a professional truck driver; a preacher, law enforcement officer/security, and finally retired as an educator from the Oklahoma City Public School System.

His hobbies were reading, gardening, 'RV'ing and HO gauge railroad train modeling.
