Robert attended Douglass High School he worked as a Journeyman Press Operator for Oklahoma Graphics where he retired from.

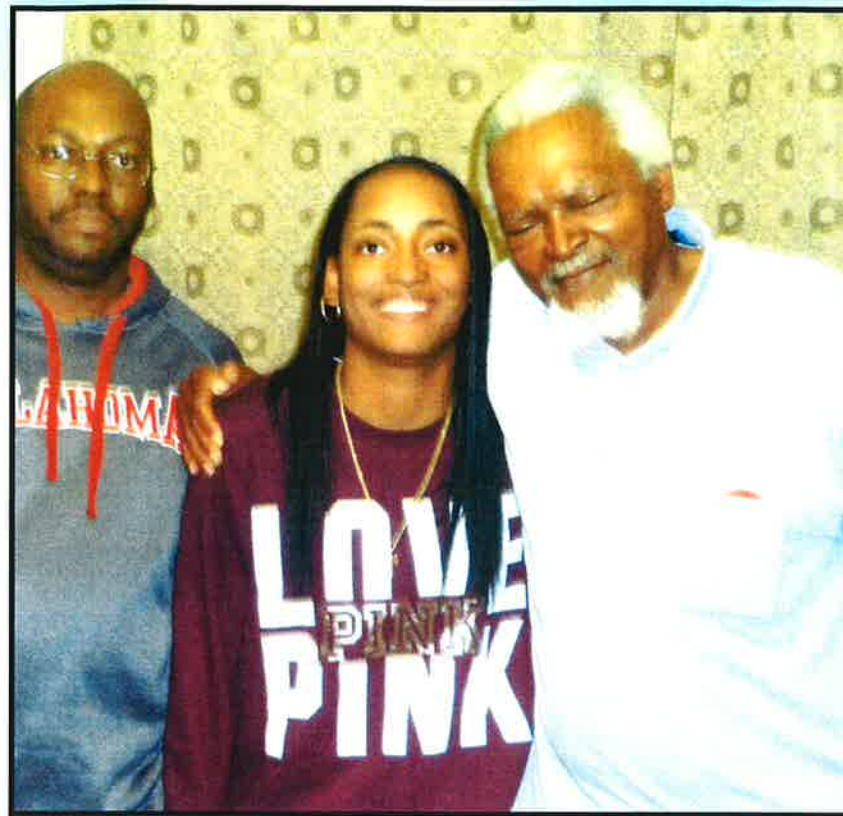
Robert accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior early in life.
