



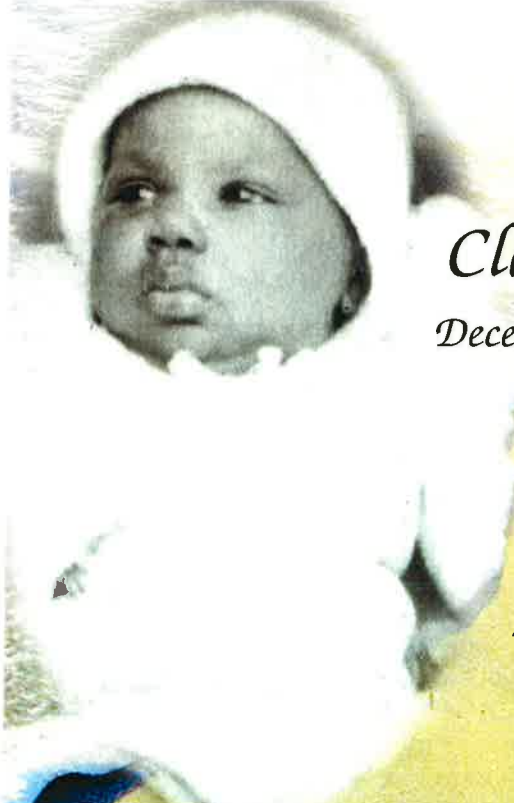

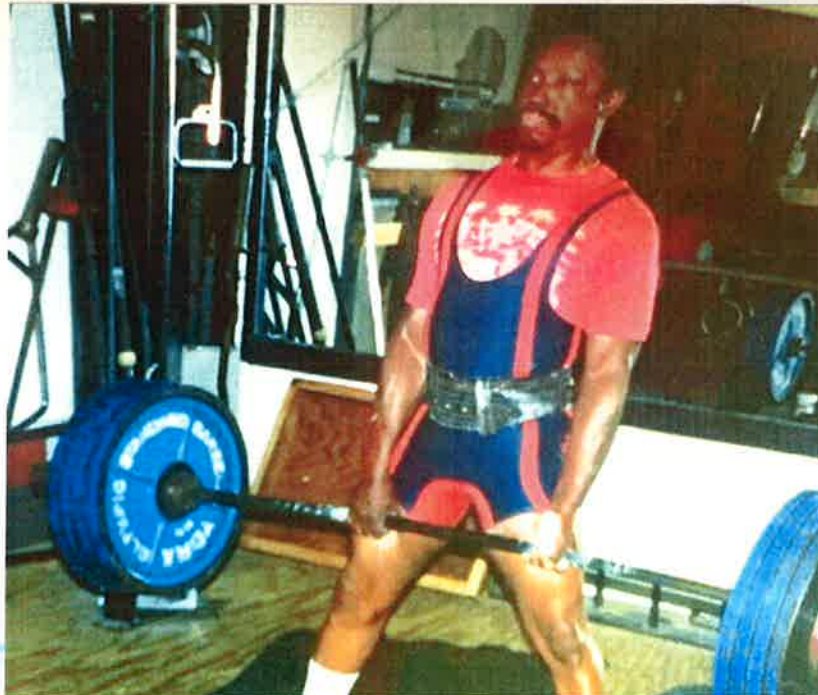
Clark attended Douglass High School, but left school before completing his senior year to serve his country by way of the United States Navy.
