Obituary

Mattie Jewel Kilpatrick was born June 9, 1944 to Will and Mattie Davis in Childress, Texas. She was the last of eight children born to this union.

Mattie Jewel received her education in the Dunjee Public School System. She was a member of the Dunjee High School class of 1962. During her years at Dunjee she was a very active student, the basketball co-captain, and head majorette.

At an early age, Mattie Jewel was baptized at Green Pastures Church of Christ where she worshipped until moving to Spencer Church of Christ in 1972. There she was an active member, served on the benevolence committee, and headed up the grief committee.
