# *Phillip E. Jones, Jr.*

Phillip Ethelberth Jones, Jr. was born in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on August 6, 1944 to Phillip E. Jones, Sr. and Willa Barbara Odom Jones. He attended Douglass High School as a freshman, moved to Chicago, Illinois when his mother married Elliott 8. Stewart, and graduated from Harlan High School in 1962 in the upper 20% of his class. He was also an athlete and he received several athletic trophies. He was an only child until his mother gave birth to his sisters Kay, Fay, and Sherri Stewart when he was already a teenager.

He was honorably discharged from the U.S. Army after he had served from 1965-1967 in Germany as a teletype operator during the Vietnam era. An Army buddy, who was also his classmate at Harlan High School, introduced Phillip to his wife's friend, Sandra L. Harper and he married her in 1970. In 1973, they welcomed their son, Erik P. Jones into the world and they were married for 15 years.

He was always a gentlemen and his love of music and pop trivia was enjoyed by the staff members of the Ardmore Veteran's Center, where he was confirmed to be dead at about 11:00 p.m. on December 29, 2020.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Willa B. Stewart, his step-father, Elliott 8. Stewart, his birth father Phillip E. Jones, Sr. and his wife Dorothy, and his sister Sherri J.
