Viola M. Brooks departed her earthly home on Thursday May 20, 2021 to enter her eternal resting place.

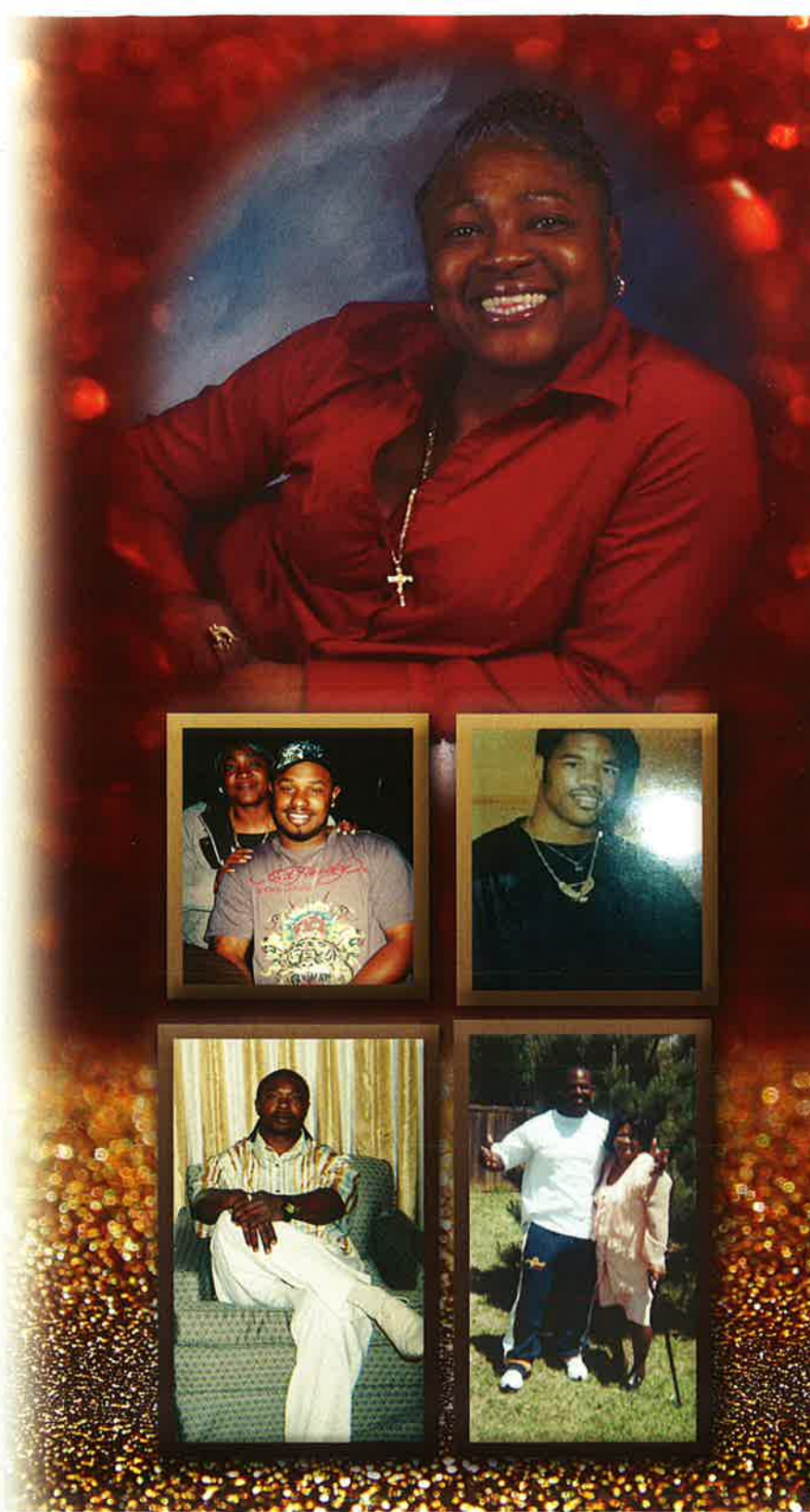
