OBITUARY

A life so beautifully lived in the service of God deserves to be beautifully remembered.

Sandra L. Lawrence was born in Wichita, KS on June 18, 1955 to Beulah M. Norwood Lawrence and Wallace Coral Lawrence. She vividly remembered the train ride on the move from Kansas to Oklahoma. Her family fondly remembers her as "Sanny", who loved to cook, fish, play dominos, and root loudly for OU and Dallas Cowboy football. And her disdain at having her picture taken was widely known.

She graduated from Star Spencer High School, after spending most of her high school years at Dunjee High School in Spencer, OK with a spark of activism after being taught by the famous Clara Luper. Sandra went on to receive her Licensed Practical Nurse certification from Metro Technology Center in Oklahoma City, OK. She would continue to work as a nurse in hospitals and nursing homes like Walter Reed Hospital in DC, and various bases like Fort Rucker and Fort Bragg, until her retirement from Fort Sill in 2017. She often spoke about her preference to work with elderly patients so that she could comfort them with the word of God at the end of their lives.

At the age of 16, she was blessed with her son Keith DeWayne Lawrence. Shortly after, she was blessed with her first daughter, Chiritta LaDawn Lawrence (Jacobs). She then met Keith Pollard, and they were wed in 1976. Later that year, they welcomed the birth of a daughter, Aundrea Yvonne Pollard (Van Order). Keith and Sandra would go on to have a son Kendrick, who sadly died in infancy. And then, several years later, and what they would jokingly refer to as an "afterthought", they would have another daughter, NiQuita Lynette Pollard (Clark) in 1983.

Sandra's dedication to God, her church, her community and family could only be described with words like unwavering, intense, tenacious, etc. She put in many hours in the church, going on youth trips, cleaning the church on Saturdays, and participating in many, many volunteering opportunities. She climbed through the ranks of the ministry, eventually achieving the title of Prophetess, and earning her official ministry credentials in December 2019.

Sandra is preceded in death by her parents, Wallace and Beulah Lawrence, a sister Crystal Lawrence, two brothers Eugene Moore and Wallace Lawrence Jr., two children Kendrick Pollard and Aundrea Van Order, a sister in law Blanche and a niece Charisma Grey.
