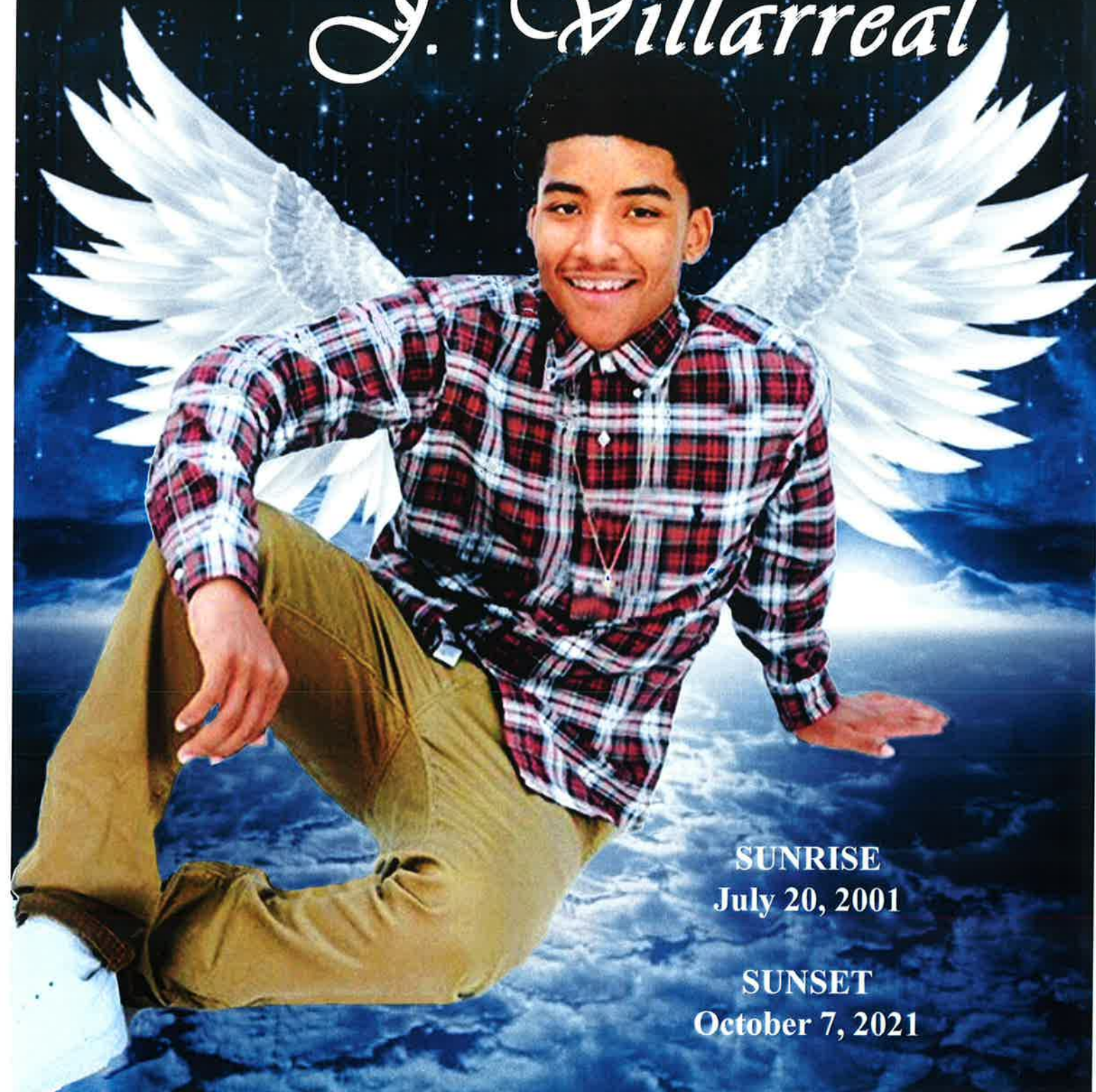

So I try to send you signs so you know you are not alone.

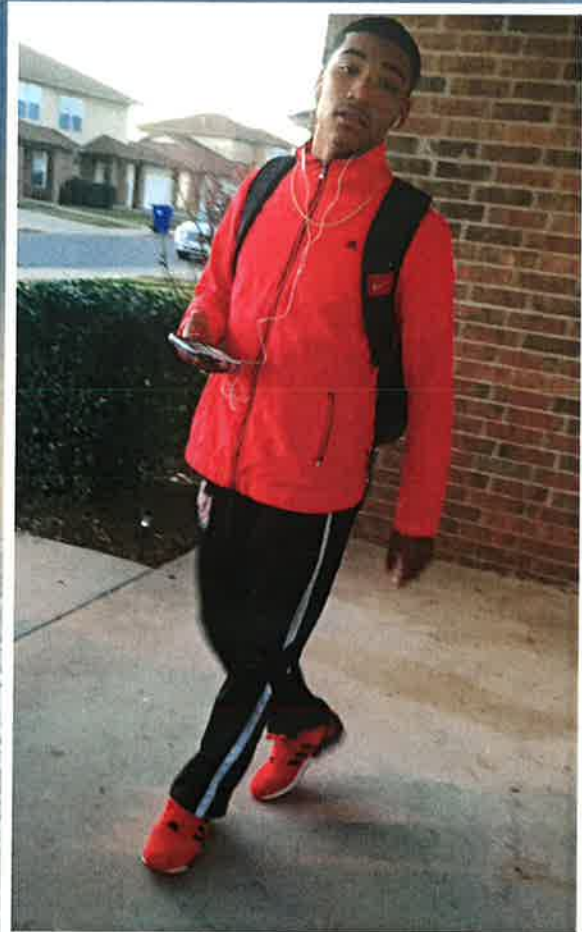
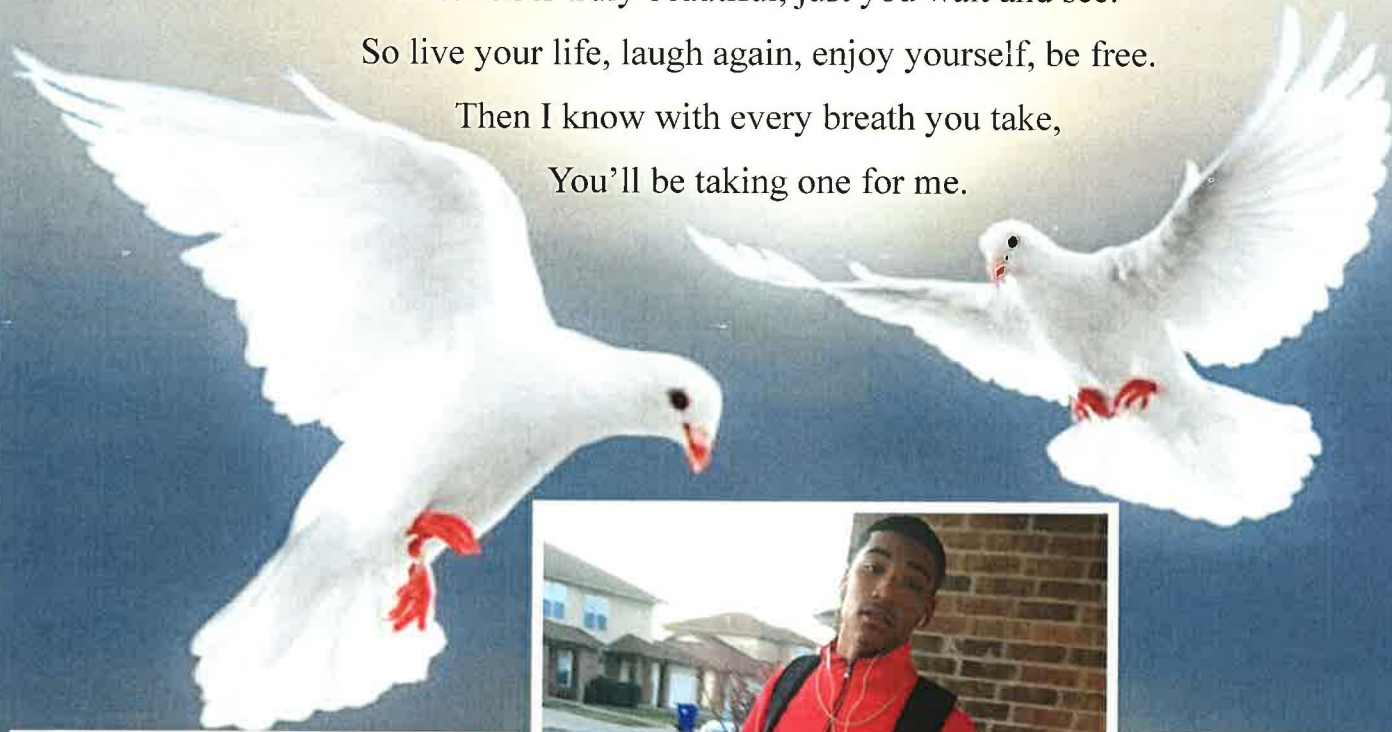
Don't feel guilty that you have life that was denied to me.

but nothing ever could compare

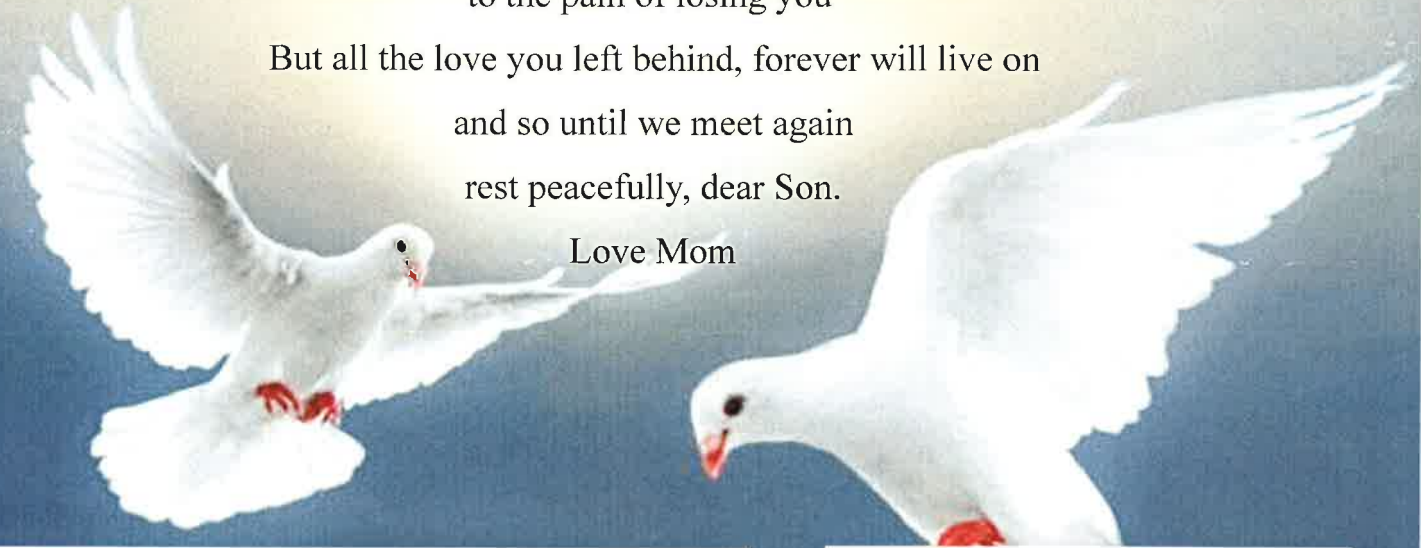

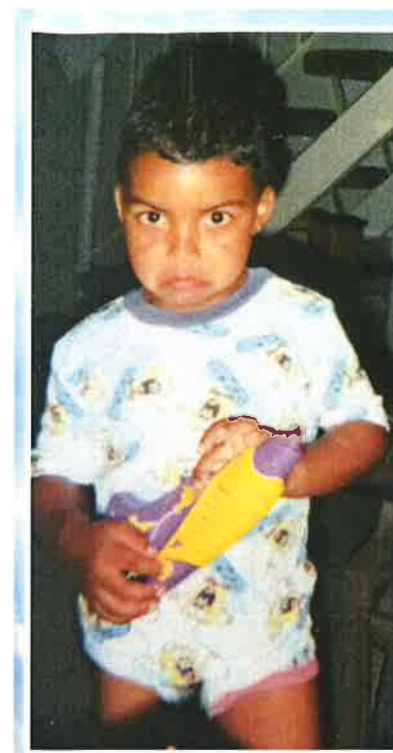
