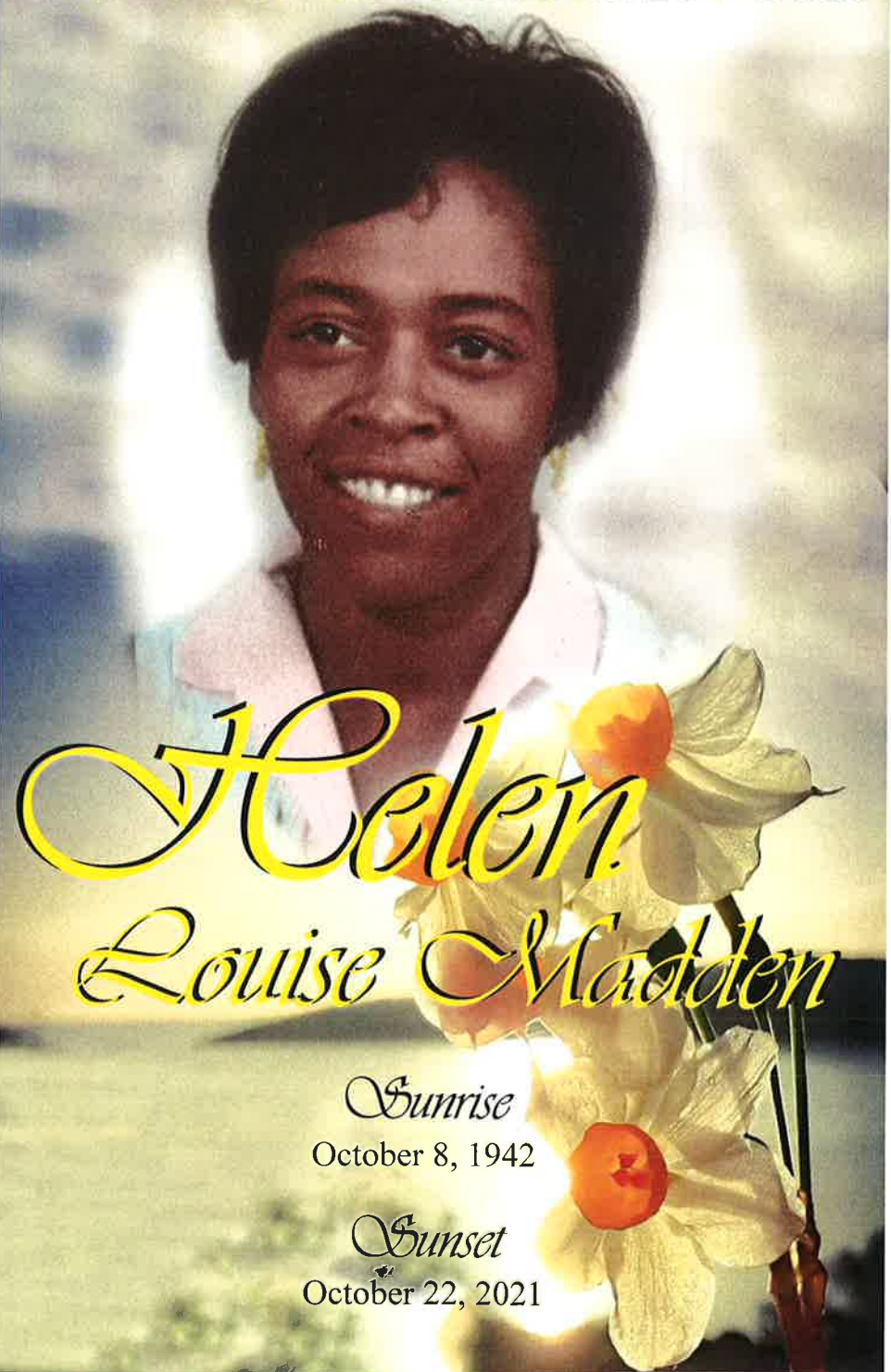

Helen enjoyed gardening, going to thrift stores, traveling, church activities, and spending time with family and friends.

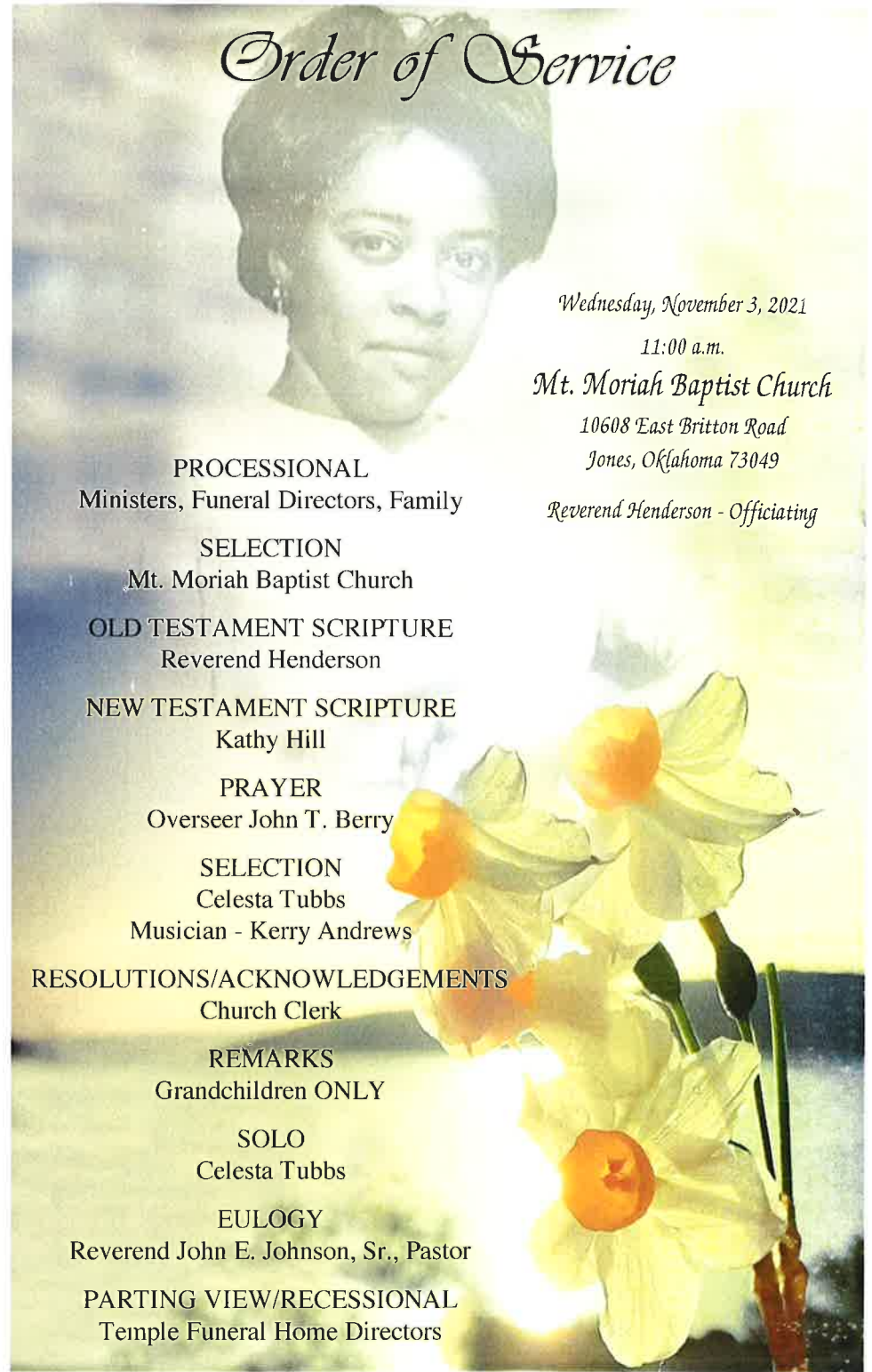
