



Obituary


Anthony Lee Hooks was birthed into this world on April 27, 1969 in San Diego, California. He was born to the union of Castella and Johnnie Lee Hooks.


Anthony was preceded in death by his father, Johnnie Lee Hooks and his sister, Ellen Hooks.
