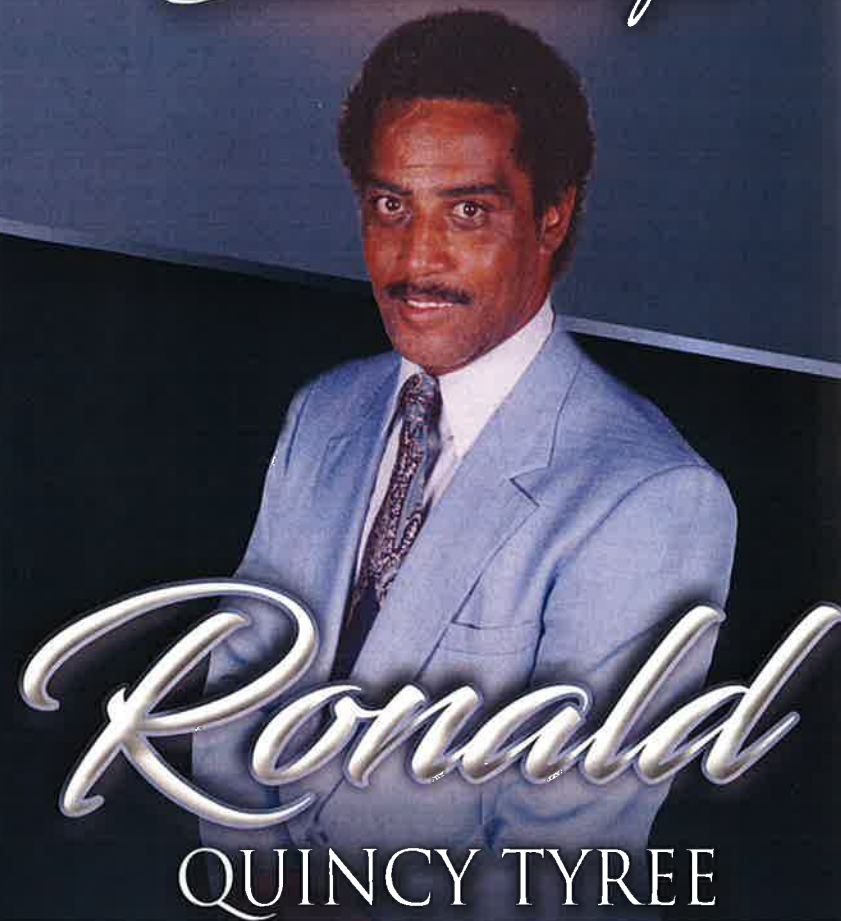

Expressions of "Ronnie" Tyree's Life

Ronald Quincy Tyree was born August 26, 1949 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to the proud parents of Bettie Jean Tyree and Elmo Quincy Tyree. Ronnie was the second of three children born to this union along with Varita Tyree Taylor, his oldest sister, and Delvin Tyree, his younger brother. In 1954, the family moved to San Francisco, California where Ronnie grew up in the family home on 314 Shields Street. Ronnie completed his formal education and graduated from Lincoln High School in 1967.

After completion of his education, Ronnie was inducted in the United States Army on July 23, 1969. During his time in the Army he served in the Vietnam War and was honorably awarded a National Defense Service Medal, a Vietnam Service Medal, and a Vietnam Campaign Medal. After returning from Vietnam, Ronnie returned to California for a short while then moved to Oklahoma City.
