Obituary

Evangie Hytche McGlon was born October 5, 1925 to Hayes Hytche and Bethel L. Hytche in Tallahassee, Oklahoma. She moved with her parents to Oklahoma City at an early age of eight years, where she grew up and attended public schools. After graduating from high school, she worked for Learners Dress Shop in Oklahoma City and later took a job at Tinker Air Force Base, working on the 1st assembly line, providing parts for aircraft. After working for several years, she was lead by faith to continue her education. She attended Central State College, in Edmond, Oklahoma. There, she received two Bachelor of Science Degrees in Education on May 25, 1961. Shortly after graduating, she was hired and worked in the Oklahoma City Public School System, teaching elementary students. She was well received by her students and their parents. Her ability to motivate students in the classroom from an academic point of view, was noticed by the Board of Education and the Community at Large. Through her ability to motivate students she was asked to accept a position, at an all-white elementary school, known as Stonegate. After teaching in the district for several years, she once again was lead by faith to pursue a graduate degree at Central State University. On July 29, 1973, she received 2 Master of Education Degrees, she became a School Counselor or Pyschometrist, providing psychological testing to students in the school district at area schools. She decided to continue her education and received a Doctor of Philosophy on May 12, 1979, from the University of Oklahoma. Shortly after, receiving her Doctor Degree, she accepted a teaching position at Oklahoma State University. In that capacity, she taught students pursuing Bachelor and Graduate Degrees in Education. She would often visit her students in the field and was very supportive in meeting their education and emotional needs. Under the jurisdiction of Oklahoma State University, she traveled to China, Tokyo and Canada, teaching education and behavioral courses as an Exchange Professor. Dr. Evangie McGlon taught at Oklahoma State University from 1979 to 1990.

In grateful recognition of her loyal services, Oklahoma State University issued the Diploma of Merit and conferred upon her the title of Professor Emertius.

She confessed a hope in Christ at an exceedingly early age. In later years, she united with the Tabernacle Baptist Church. Her affiliations consist of being a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

On January 31, 2022, Dr. Evangie McGlon peacefully went home. She was preceded in death by her parents, Hayes W. and Bethel L. Hytche, two sisters and five brothers. She leaves to cherish her memory, one daughter Mrs. Joycelyn Calhoun and one son, Joseph P. McGlon III (wife Joyce), two grandchildren, Olafemi and Lukeman Calhoun; four great grandchildren.
