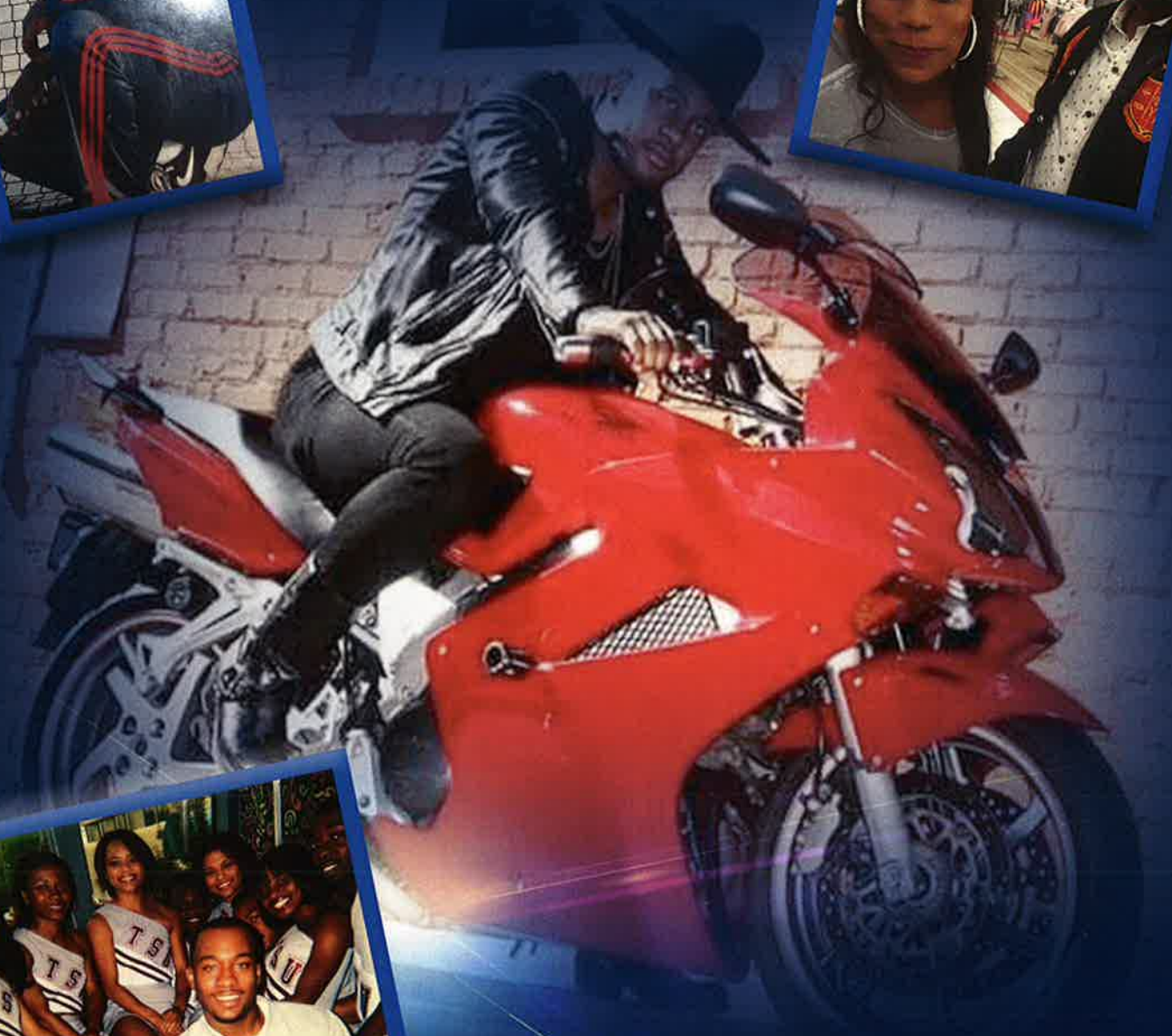

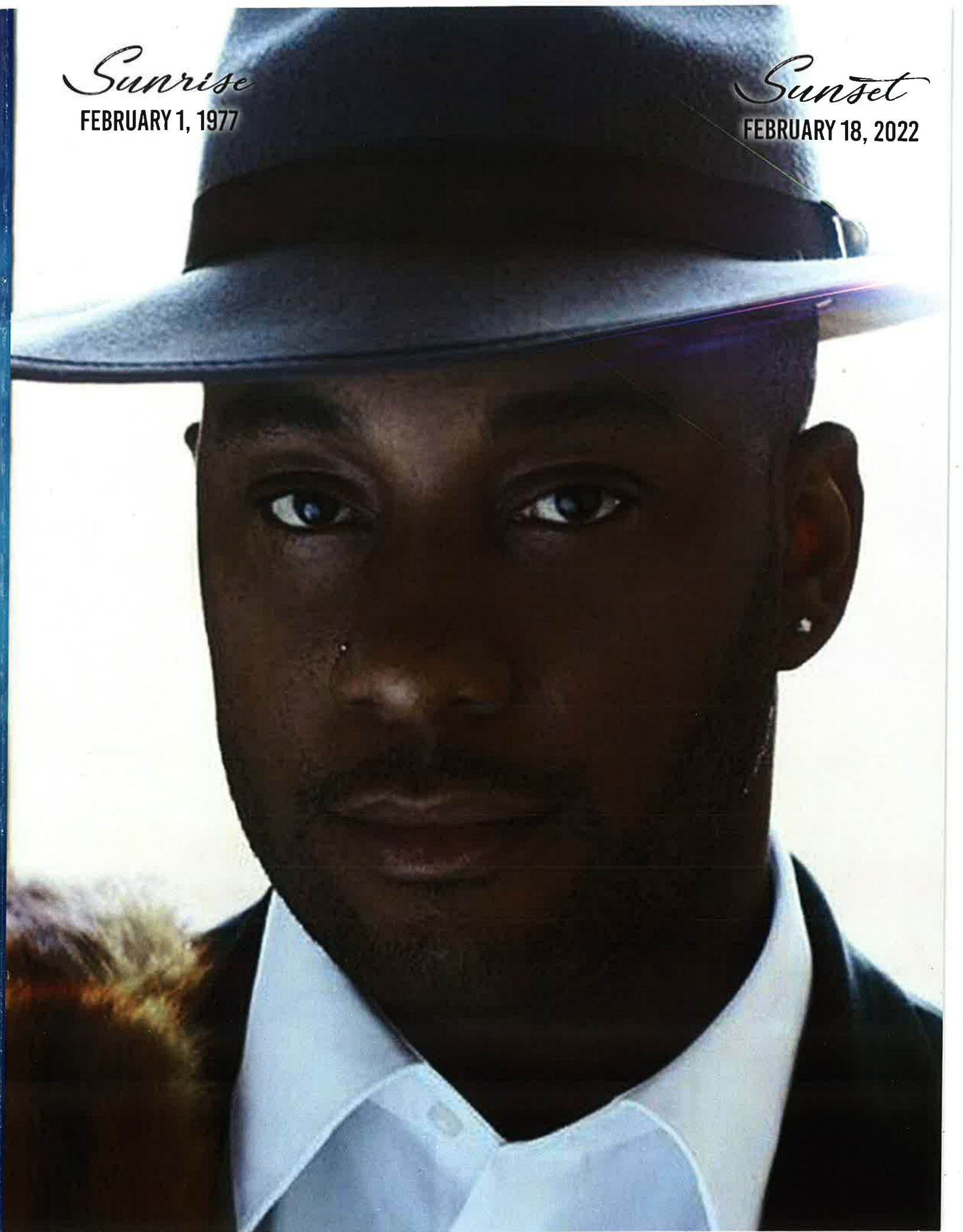
Family Gratitude
