## Obituary

Lorene Louise Beard was born February 29, 1928 in Wellington Texas. She was the only child born to Ms. Pearl Idella McCook and Mr. Legus Beard. Although Lorene was born in Texas, she had deep roots in Seminole County, Oklahoma. As a child she moved to Oklahoma City with her mother, but she would love to visit with cousins and family in Seminole and Wewoka Oklahoma.

Lorene began her education at Page Elementary in Oklahoma City as a child and later attended Douglass Middle School and High School. As a Douglass graduate of the class of 1945, she was a proud Trojan. She was known to always root for them at football games, especially during the years when her only son Nathaniel "Oogie" Fowler was a star football player. She also enjoyed watching her only daughter Cheryl Minter on the field as a majorette. Twenty years after high school, Lorene decided to obtain a cosmetology degree and became a licensed cosmetologist in 1965.

She worked in this area until she retired with over 25 years of civil service. While at Tinker, she was able to foster many meaningful friendships that continued even after her retirement. Lorene was raised in the Church of the Living God - Christian Workers For Fellowship (C.W.F.F.) and remained faithful until her health and mobility would no longer allowed her to attend services.
