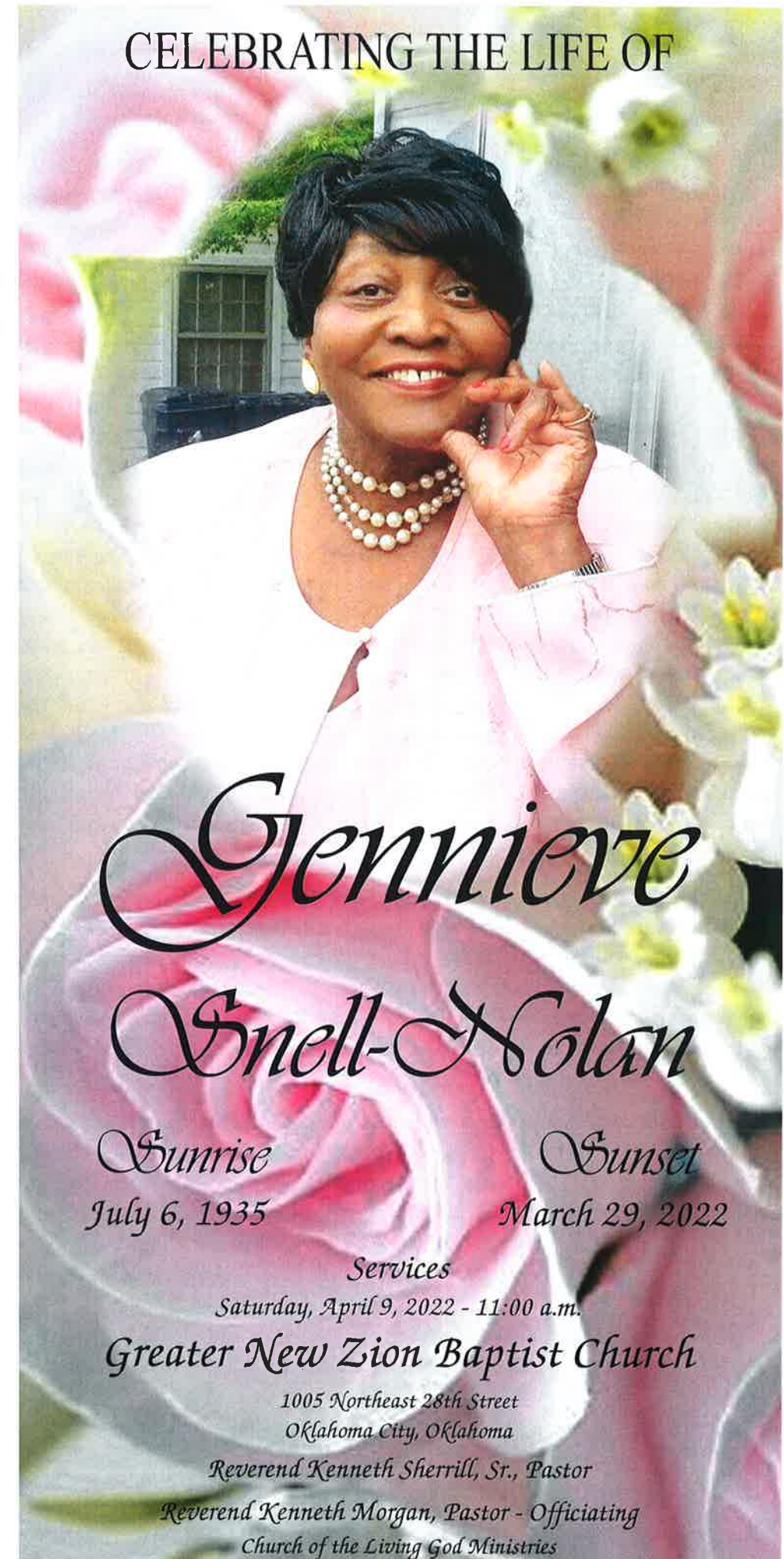

# Obituary

Gennieve Moore Snell-Nolan was born July 6, 1935, in Kendrick, Oklahoma, to Tate and Lucy Moore. She was the fourth of eight children.

Her family moved to Stroud, Oklahoma, where she attended Stroud Elementary School and Morning Star Middle School. She attended Douglass High School in Oklahoma City. She also attended Gordon-Cooper Vo-Tech, where she completed the LPN course, becoming a Licensed Practical Nurse. Mrs. Nolan fell in love with Christ at an early age and was baptized at age 16, at Mt. Pilgrim Baptist Church, in Oklahoma City, OK. There, she served as a member for several long years, under the leadership of Rev. Petes. She later became a member of First Christian Church of Boley, Oklahoma, under the leadership of Reverend C.B. Nichols. She then became a member of Sunnyslane Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. J.J. Blassengill. Her final church home was Church of The Living God Ministries, under the leadership of Pastor Kenneth Morgan. Although Mrs. Nolan was a good and faithful servant, her passion was working with the youth. When she was no longer able to attend church service, in person, she continued her service through prayer. She enjoyed praying on both of the prayer lines, of which, she was a part. She was a member of Live Oak Chapter #54 Order of The Eastern Star Queen Bethsheba Grand Junction of Oklahoma. She served as Grand Matron of this order, at one point. Mrs. Nolan genuinely enjoyed being a caregiver. She worked at the Boley nursing home as a CNA. She also worked at Okemah Hospital as a CNA and LPN. She worked at the University Hospital, in Oklahoma City, OK, as an LPN, from which she retired after 20 years of dedicated service. In 1953, Gennieve met and married Fay Snell, Sr. To this union ten children were born. Fay Snell, Sr., one son, Bobby Don Snell, and one daughter, Beverly Diane Snell, preceded her in death.

After years and years of extending her love to others, God rewarded her work. She met and married a most wonderful man, whose heart of love genuinely matched her own. He loved her children, grandchildren and extended family, and every one of her babies was his. On August 19, 2000, Gennieve married Harvey Nolan, Jr. They shared a love for elegance, and was one of the best-dressed couples you ever did see. Her beloved husband departed this life in 2011, also preceding her in death.
