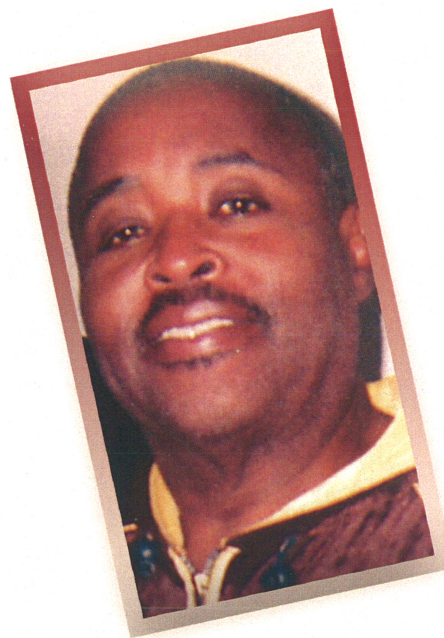
IN LOVING MEMORY
