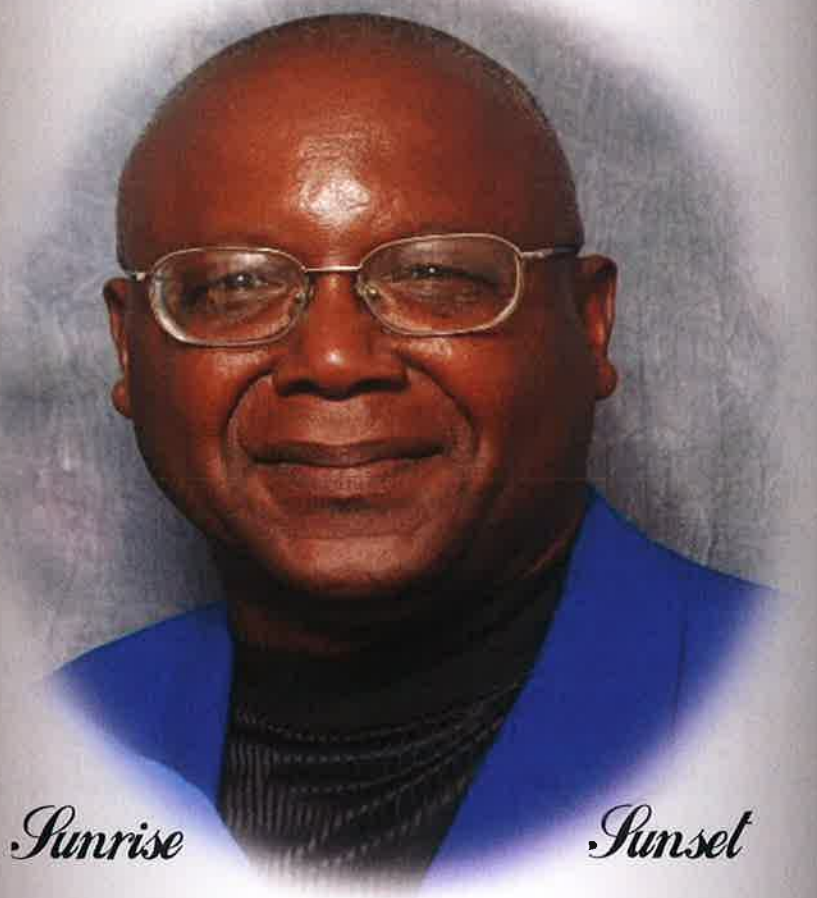

Obituary

Wilbert Clarence Wallace was born September 22, 1949, to Lee Mack Wallace Sr. and Lula Mae Simms in Wellston, Oklahoma. On Tuesday, May 10th, 2022 the Lord called His servant home to rest. He is preceded in death by his parents Lee Mack Sr. and Lula Mae Wallace.

Wilbert was baptized, and attended Greater Cleaves Memorial Baptist Church. On March 7th, 1992, Wilbert was united in Holy Matrimony to his wife Deadrea M. Tabb whom he met while working for the City of Oklahoma City. He joined Greater New Zion Baptist Church where they married and maintained his membership until his passing.

As a child, Wilbert enjoyed life in a big family of four sisters and six brothers. Growing up, his mother instilled strong Christian values and hard work ethics. In high school, he enjoyed running track, playing baseball, and was very good at it. He attended Wellston High School where he graduated in 1968. Shortly after graduating, he joined the United States Army, and later the Army Reserves.

Wilbert's hard work and work ethic would soon lead him to several careers. He worked for the City of Oklahoma City for 32 years in which he retired in 2000. While working for the City, he also worked for Kiddy Village for several years. Wilbert never had just one job, he maintained several, and some at the same time.

After retirement, he stayed busy working. He worked as the Crossing Guard for seven years at Nichols Hills Elementary, Jamil's Restaurant, custodian, and church bus driver at Greater New Zion Baptist Church. Wilbert even managed to be his own boss by selling watermelons and vegetables on weekends to his countless customers. Wallace was known around town for the kindness, and helping hand he showed others. He had a tremendous passion for helping others which gained him a loving reputation in the community.

Wilbert also had a group of friends who helped him with his watermelon business. Big E , Butch, Corey, Faye, James, and JR who are much appreciated.

Wilbert was always there for family gatherings, he enjoyed having a seat at the domino, and card table. Wilbert loved cooking, along with fishing when time permitted.

Wilbert was a longtime valued active member in the affairs of the Prince Hall Free, and Accepted Ancient Yorkrite Masonic family. He also served as Grand Master for the Prince Hall Free and Accepted Ancient York Rite Masonic family; Jurisdiction of Oklahoma; Prince Hall Origin, National Compact from 2017 until 2021. Wilbert served as Past Worshipful Master of Pride of Oklahoma Lodge #31.
