He graduated from Colbert High School in 1966.

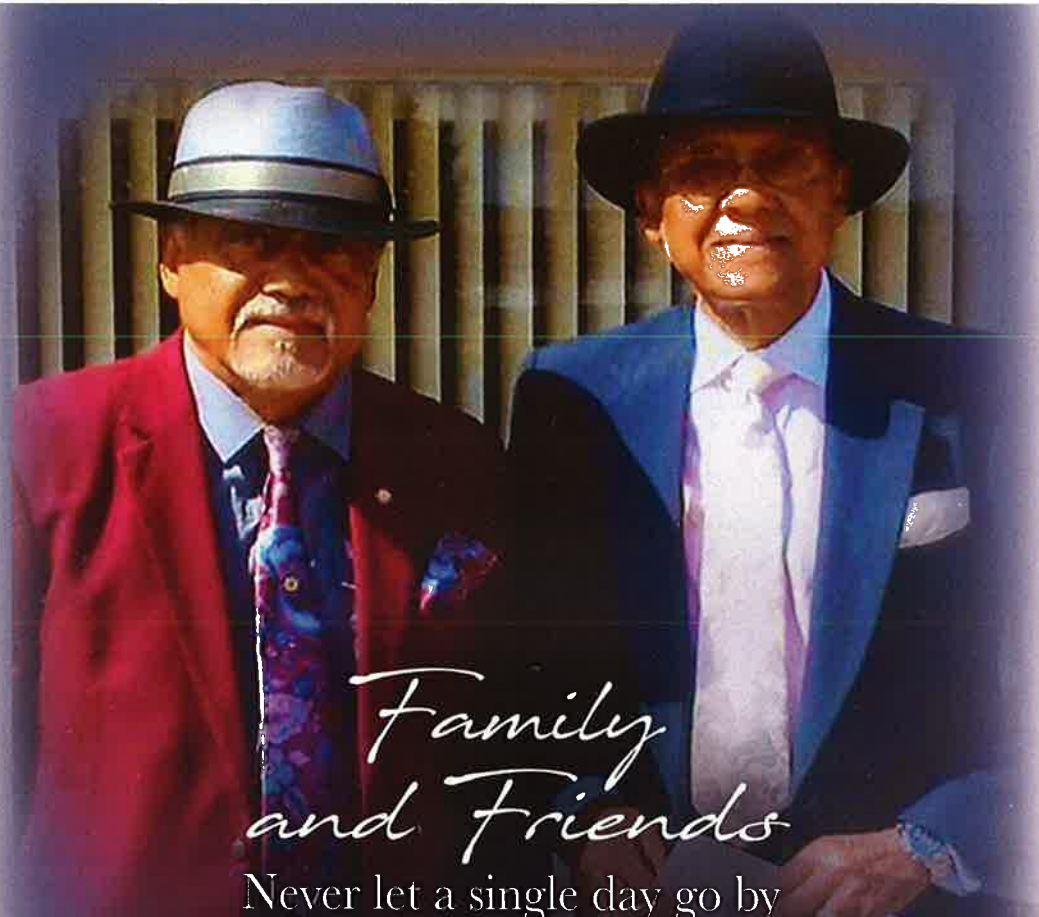
Keith was introduced to Christianity at Lee's Chapel AME Methodist Church in Colbert.
