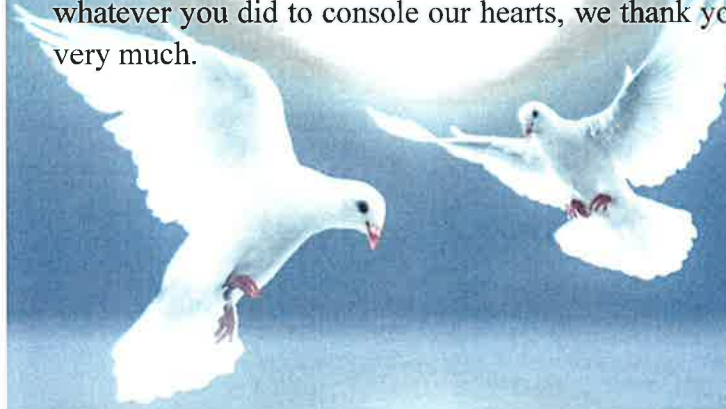

Obituary

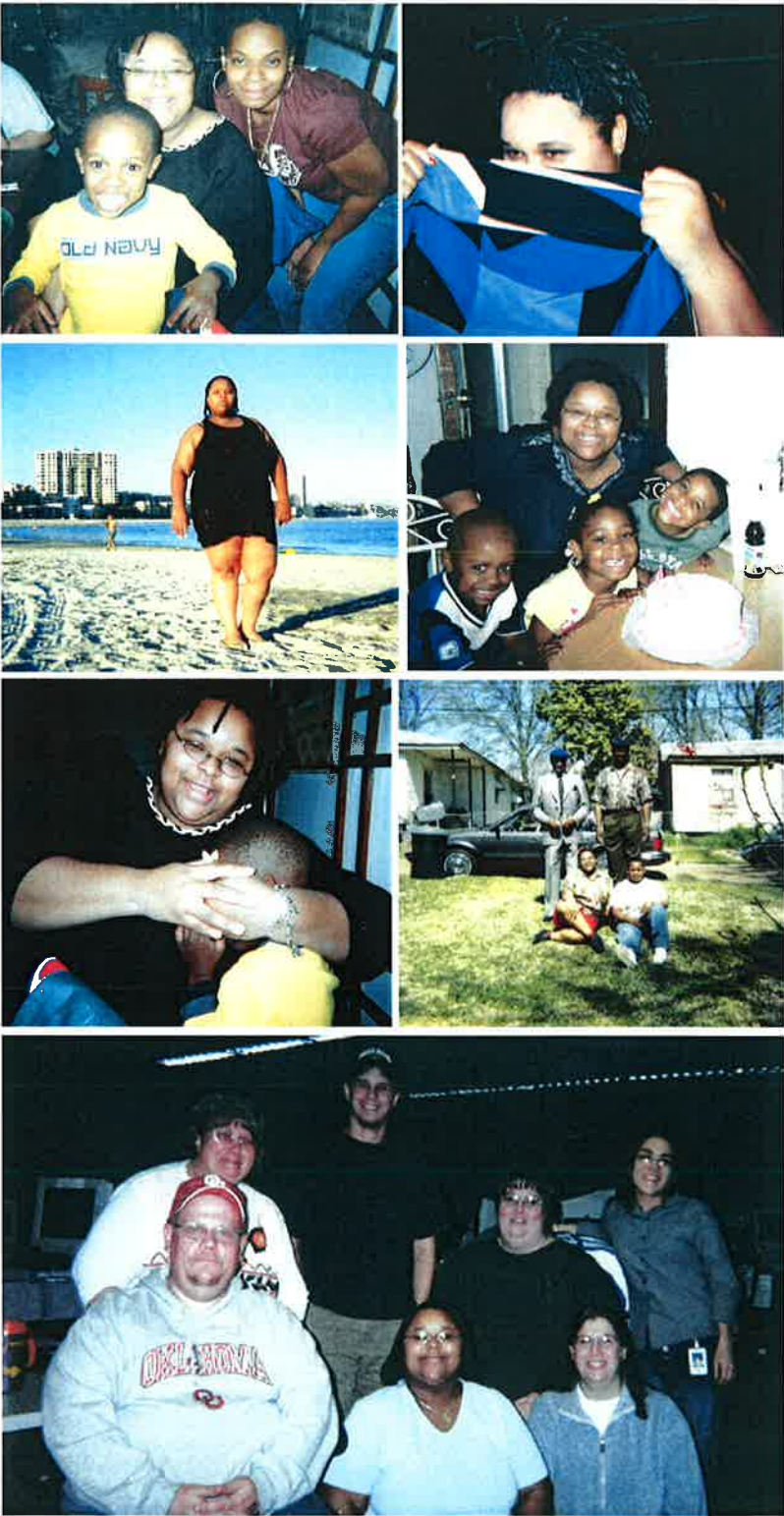
Kalisha M. Kinchen was born April 15, 1977 in New Orleans, Louisiana. Kalisha was the second of three children.
