Sheila Younger was born on February 1, 1949, in Oklahoma City to Romaine Younger and Anna McGlory. She was the third child born of six children. Sheila grew up in Oklahoma City, graduating from Douglass High School in 1967. She accepted Christ at an early age and began her Christian journey at St. John Missionary Baptist Church, where she sang in the youth choir and remained an active and faithful member until her health declined.

On August 28, 2022, Sheila transitioned from labor to reward. She was 73 years old.

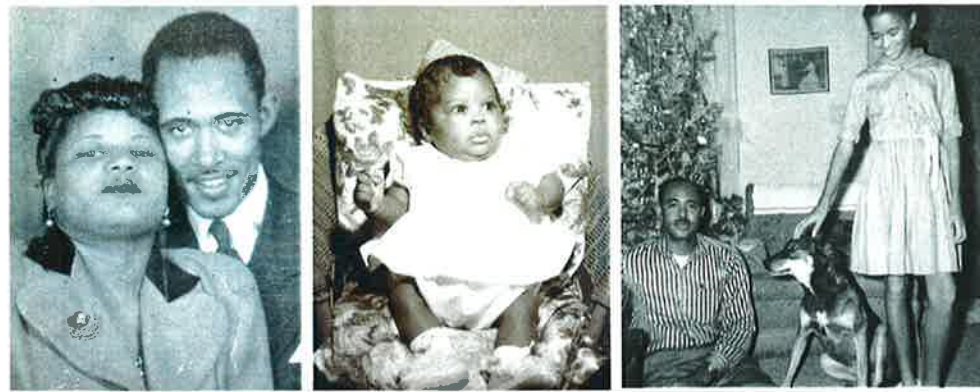
Sheila was a loving and God-fearing mother to Onthronette Pendarvis and Tyree Watley.

In 1977, Sheila was employed as a bookkeeper at Medical Center State Bank until she was awarded 100 percent disability in 1985.

Sheila loved going to the lake and spending time with her family. In her leisure, she enjoyed listening to several of her 1970s R&B favorites, namely Marvin Gaye and Smokey Robinson. Her pleasant, jovial personality attracted many, and she was known for making her family and friends laugh, shining a light on the humorous side of life.

In 1983, Sheila was diagnosed and began her fight with Multiple Sclerosis (MS). As an unwavering warrior battling MS, she made the disease her life's purpose, advocating and serving as a living testimony to what prayer and faith in God could do. While hospitalized in 2013, seven doctors could not believe Sheila would survive a few surgical procedures. However, nine years after undergoing the operation, GOD continued to favor and bless her life. In 2021 and 2022, respectively, Sheila contracted and suffered from COVID, and on one occasion, she was placed on life support, yet Jesus spared her life. With the help of our almighty God, Sheila beat the odds throughout her entire life, remaining a constant inspiration and a tower of strength to her family, friends, and all those, who crossed her path.

Sheila Younger was preceded in death by her parents, Romaine Younger and Anna McGlory. She leaves to cherish her memory and legacy of her two children: Onthronette Pendarvis (Houston, TX) and Tyree Watley (Oklahoma City); her brothers: Terry Younger (deceased), Donald Younger (deceased), Charles Jackson, and Donald Jackson.
