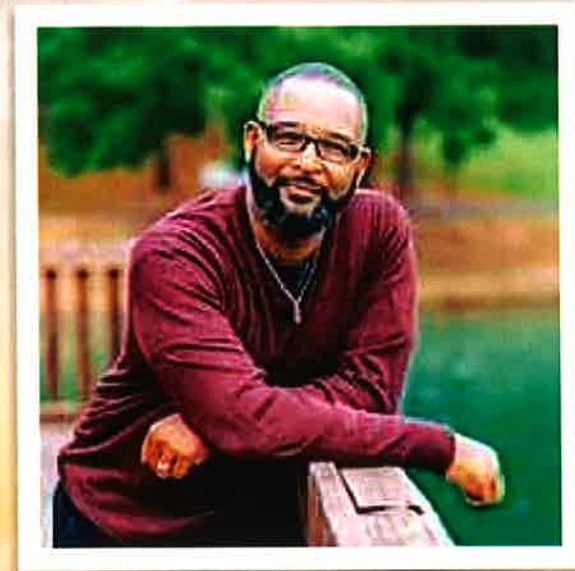

# Obituary



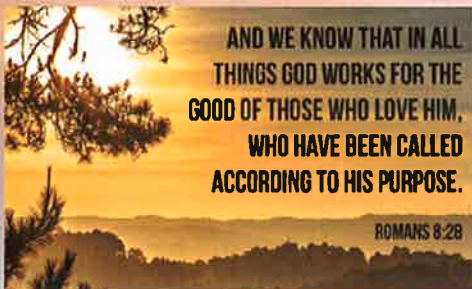
