Obituary

Stacy Lynn Davis, was born on March 28, 1973, at Wesley Medical Center in Wichita, Kansas, to Rose Davis-Vinson and the late Nathaniel Davis. Stacy was also affectionately called “Bert”.

Stacy accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age at First Baptist Church, Coalgate, Oklahoma, and was baptized there. Stacy was a true believer and depended on Jesus throughout her lifetime. After the first 14 days in ICU, the medical team decided to take out the tube that went down her throat to determine if she could breathe on her own. She had been anxious to have this out so she could verbally communicate. Stacy was specifically instructed by the nurse not to talk for two hours. As soon as the tube was removed she shouted out “Thank God” three times. During the painful times of her extended ICU stay, she would call out “Lord have mercy”.

Stacy was educated in the public schools in Coalgate, Oklahoma.

Stacy was “Mama” to four children, who she proudly raised. She was described as a quiet, no-nonsense, wonderful, loving mother. Stacy was also a hard worker, working 22 years in food service. At the time of her death, she was employed as Dietary Supervisor at Arbor House Assisted Living Center. She had a strong work ethic and instilled that same work ethic in her four children.

Stacy was proceeded in death by her father Nathaniel Davis; her stepfather, Lloyd Vinson; grandparents, Veter Lee Perkins, Kenneth Perkins, Mary Ann Arterberry, John Davis; and uncle, Frank Richardson.
