Obituary

Eugene Frederick King, Jr. was born November 30, 1945 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to Eugene F., Sr. and Mildred M. King. He was the third of six children.

He accepted Christ as his personal Savior at an early age. He was baptized by Rev. S.S. Fairly at Fairview Baptist Church in Oklahoma City. He remained a faithful member until joining another congregation in Oklahoma City. Eugene's faith journey led him to several local churches where he served in the Youth Ministry. On Friday, January 6, 2023, Eugene transitioned from labor to reward. He was preceded in death by his parents, and his brothers, William H. King and Wallace V. King.

He is survived by; his children: Christopher Todd and Anjanette Kae King; his Grandchildren; Olivia Raven King, Grayson Christopher King and Patrick (P.J.) Dwayne Eason, Jr.; Sisters: Anita Y.
