

Leonard Edd was born September 30, 1950 in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Reverend Leon Edd and Lula Louise Reed-Edd. Born as the third of six children, Leonard was loved by all who met him. Leonard was raised by loving parents who were the embodiment of the church, love of God, importance of family, hard work
