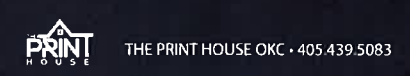

Soon after graduation, she obtained employment at the Oklahoma League for the Blind where she met the love of her life, Karl Williams.

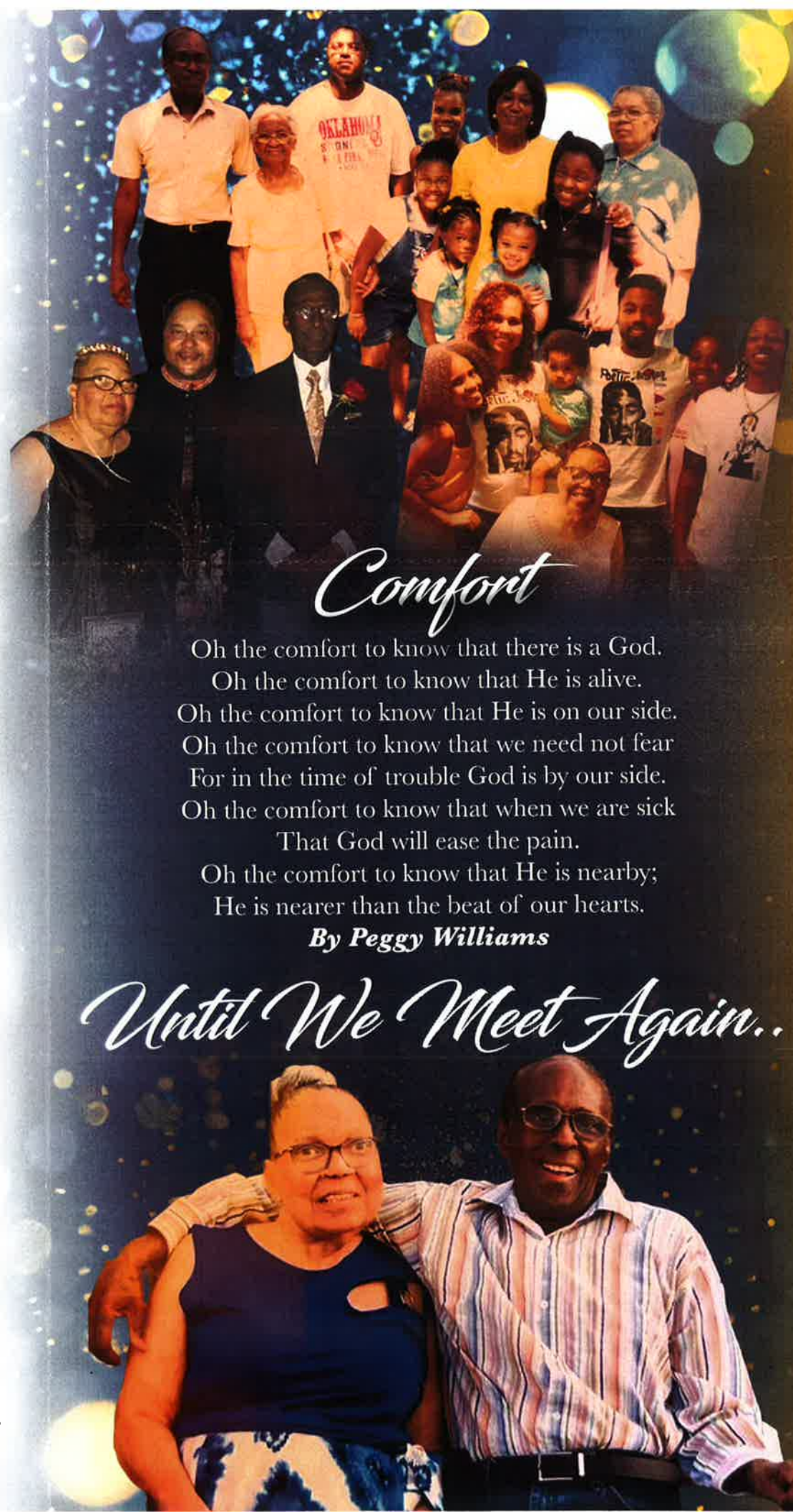
Peggy and Karl married on December 10, 1966, and to this union two children were born: Karla Yvette and Michael Lawrence. She dedicated her life to taking care of her children.
