Obituary

Elder Melvin Kornegay, Jr. was born on January 25, 1940 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to Melvin Kornegay, Sr. and Bertha M. Kornegay. His father, mother, and brother, Elder John Collins, preceded him in death.

Melvin graduated from Douglass High School in 1958 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma where he studied carpentry. Later, he met and married Doris Jean Pendleton of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. From this union a son, Melvin Ricky Kornegay was born.

Melvin worked for the famous Ned's Steakhouse as a Chef for many years before starting his own carpentry business, K&K Trim and Remodeling for 45 years and later contracted with the Oklahoma City Housing Authority, from which he retired.

Melvin was saved and filled with the Holy Ghost and placed his membership with Evangelist Temple COGIC under the leadership of Supt. Elder J.R. Sapp, where he was later called to the ministry. His ministry led him to New Jerusalem Temple COGIC, under the leadership of Pastor, Elder Bobby L. Williams, and later First Church COGIC, under the leadership of Pastor, Elder Howard Q. Jones, presently Jones Chapel COGIC, under the leadership of Pastor, Elder Gilbert A. Oliver.

He dedicated his life to evangelism and worked with the COGIC Southeast Oklahoma Jurisdiction State Evangelist Department. Melvin also served as Sunday School President at his local church and for the Greater Central District COGIC. He served in many capacities in his local church until he was called home to meet the Lord.

Melvin enjoyed fishing, watching sports, and spending time with his wife, children, and grandchildren. He loved studying and preaching the word of God.
