# Obituary

Joe Louis Plunkett was born August 18, 1939 to David Lewis and Estella Ruth Plunkett in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Joe attended Frederick Douglass High School in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and was in the graduating class of 1957. After graduating from high school, he entered the United States Army Reserve and served two years of service (1958-1960). Joe met and fell in love with Thelma Jean Williams and they were married July 2, 1960. To this union three sons were born: Gregory, Joe Jr. and Eric.

At an early age, Joe accepted Christ. He and his family later joined Greater Bethel Baptist Church under the direction of Reverend C.C. Cooper. Joe was a very faithful member. He gave many years of his life singing, serving families and always preached about love and being a faithful Christian. After retiring, he became self-employed. He always did hard work, helping others and enjoyed a lot of family time.

Joe leaves one son, Eric L. Plunkett; two daughters-in-law: Millicent and Deloris Plunkett; his brother, David Lewis Plunkett (JR), Lloyd Wayne Plunkett and Walter Plunkett; his sisters: Helen Plunkett and Deloris Smith. He also leaves behind eight grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.
