




Life Reflections

On November 28, 1923, in the city of Hugo, OK, Curtis Foreman, Sr. and Liddie Beatrice Foreman became the proud parents of Curtis Foreman, Jr. He was the eldest of nine children born to this union.

The family later moved to the city of Ardmore, Oklahoma. He attended Douglass High School there where he developed his love for music. He played the Sousaphone in the marching band.

Shortly after he joined the US Navy and was honorably medically discharged.

He moved to San Francisco, CA where he was a lifeguard and a streetcar driver. He later joined the rest of his family in Phoenix, AZ.

Curtis was employed by Webber Mortuary which so happened to be next door to the beauty college. There he met the love of his life, Zenobia Kay. After three months of courtship turned into 63 years of blissful marriage. To this union three children were born: Tonda Kay, Tandy Dehon and Yvette.

In 1965 the family moved to Oklahoma City, OK where he worked for Dodson Construction Co. In 1968 the family moved to the town of Forest Park where he built the first town hall.

He was employed at Tinker Air Force Base as a sheet metal specialist. He worked in Building 3001 for over 30 years. In 1973 while working for Tinker, he became employed by Temple & Sons Funeral Directors where he later retired at age 88.

At an early age, Curtis Foreman, Jr. accepted Christ as his personal savior and was baptized. He served the Lord as Secretary of Treasury, Song Leader, sang in the choir, sang in a quartet, bus driver, landscapers, handy-man, etc. He remained "A good and faithful servant" until his decline in health. Matthew 25:23.

Curtis Jr. never met a stranger and never said No. If you needed him, he was there. He was flipping houses even before it became popular. You can see his carpentry craftsmanship all over Oklahoma. He loved animals, deep sea fishing and the Dallas Cowboys.



